The variety of topics in the submitted applications is extremely diverse and include diversity of mosses and liverworts of certain regions, environmental characteristics of different groups, syntaxonomy of bryophytes and the role of bryophytes in vegetation, taxonomy of certain groups, modern problems and approaches to their solution in taxonomy, methodological tasks...

The conference will be held on August 23–28, 2024, at the Kola Science Center, in Apatity, Murmansk Region, Russia.

The main objective of the Conference:

- Synthesize the current understanding of bryophyte research;
- Highlight the future research initiatives;
- Encourage collaboration among bryologists in- and outside of Russia;
- Recruitment to bryology young people.

Russian, English.

- font Times New Roman, 12 pt, 1.0 spacing;
- margins: top 2 cm, bottom 2 cm, left 3 cm, right 1.5 cm.

The materials of the presentations are supposed to be published in the Arctoa, a Journal of Bryology in case of receiving positive reviews and taking into account the requirements and approaches of this journal

Preliminary Agenda:

August 23th, Friday – Arrival and accommodation in hotel of Scientific Station of Kola Science Center. Collecting in the vicinity of the station

August 24th, Saturday – Welcome, plenary session, oral presentation. Excursion to the arboretum.

August 25th, Sunday – Oral presentation, poster presentation. Furshet.

August 26th, Monday – Field excursion on Western slopes of Khibiny Mountains. Study of collected specimens, discussions

August 27th, Tuesday – Field excursion in central part of Khibiny Mountains. Study of collected specimens, discussions

August 28th, Wednesday – Field excursion in valley of Aikuaivechyok River

August 29th, Thursday– Field excursion to aapa-complex mire in valley of Imandra Lake Study of collected specimens, discussions

August 30th, Friday – Departure.

Please note that depending on the weather the places of excursions may be changed. Also, depending on weather, the days with presentation may change with the days of excursions.

Key dates:

August 1, 2024 – the third information letter, preliminary conference program.

Accommodation:

The foreign participants will be accommodated in Apatity and will be transported to the conference site (Tietta House of Scientists of the Kola Scientific Center of the Russian Academy of Sciences) every day. The Tietta House of Scientists is located on the shore of Lake Imandra, 20 km from the city of Apatity.

Three meals a day will be organized on the territory of the base. The estimated cost of meals per person is 1000 rubles/day.

Field trips

To participate in excursions and field trips, you must have proper clothes. At the end of August, the weather in the region is rather good. Nevertheless, please, keep in mind and be ready for possible unexpected rain and strong cold wind. Moreover, the weather can change dramatically even during the

day. Therefore, we recommend having an upper layer of clothing made of waterproof materials, a warm intermediate layer, thermal underwear, and a hat. It is important to have waterproof shoes.

The Murmansk region is not an area of distribution of ticks carrying encephalitis virus, so there is no need to have an appropriate vaccination. However, at the end of August, blood-sucking insects may still be active. It is recommended to take personal protective equipment against mosquitoes.

Transport accessibility:

Travel to Apatity is mostly by train (www.rzd.ru) from St. Petersburg (it takes 24 hours) and Moscow (it takes 33 hours) or by airplane from Moscow and St. Petersburg (2 hours to Murmansk airport and then 3 hours to Apatity by bus or car, or two hours to the "Khibiny" airport (http://hibiny.aero/). You can also use Murmansk Airport, from where you can get to Apatity by train, bus or minibus. Since the Conference will be held during the high season, please, book your tickets in advance.

Registration fee:

100 euro (for students and postgraduates -50 euro). The details for payment of the registration fee will be given in the in the third information letter.
